****Be sure to pick a location free from overhead electrical power or telephone lines. The location should be free from trees that could damage or stain the inflatable. An unobstructed area should be maintained for 5 feet around and above the perimeter of the mini Bounce N' Dip ****

Operating Instructions:

1. Ideally, this unit should be set up on a level lawn area. If you must set it up on asphalt or another hard surface, please place blankets or other padded materials beneath it.
2. **Unroll and position the inflatable and locate the two inflation tubes on the inflatable. This inflatable has two sections. There are TWO zippers and THREE flaps that need to be closed securely to ensure no escaped air that would prevent the inflatable from blowing up completely (One flap is located on the lower left middle side, one is located on the underside of inflatable near blower, one is located in front right side under the slide, one zipper is located in the bottom back next to the blower, one is located on the left side slide middle and one on the underside of the flat part of slide of the inflatable.**
3. Place the blower in an area that is not in a direct pathway. Be certain that the blower is on a flat, dry surface free of leaves or debris.
4. Find the two inflation tubes: one of the tubes will connect to the blower, and the other tube gets tied off with the strap that is connected to it. Make sure that the tube that is strapped to the blower is on very securely.
5. Plug the blower into your dedicated 20 amp outlet. If an extension cord is needed, you must make sure that it is industrial strength. The cord needs to be 50 feet or less. Stake down the inflatable in at least two opposite corners. Cover the stakes with a suitable material to protect children while they are using the inflatable.
6. Locate the on/off switch on the blower and turn it on. Inflation should take approximately 3 minutes. The blower must remain on for the duration of the time that the inflatable is occupied.

Deflating:

1. Clean out any debris from the inside of inflatable and turn off the blower.
2. Monitor inflatable as it deflates
3. Attempt to roll inflatable back up. (We realize this is very difficult!)

**Cautions:

- Keep the front of the inflatable clear and accessible at all times.
- Please monitor children while they are using the inflatable. The maximum capacity is six children, and they should all be close in weight
- Children should always remove shoes when entering the inflatable.
- You need to make sure that you have a dedicated outlet for this inflatable. It would be best if you did not plug anything else into the same outlet.
- **Adult supervision is required at all times.**
- If the inflatable is not completely dry, please do not roll-up. Inflate and let run until dry. On a sunny day, it should only take about ½ hour.
