70' Obstacle Funhouse



****Be sure to pick a location free from overhead electrical power or telephone lines. The location should be free from trees that could damage or stain the inflatable. An open area should be maintained for 5 feet around and above the inflatable perimeter.**

Operating Instructions:

1. Ideally this unit should be set up on a level lawn area. If you must set it up on asphalt or another hard surface, please place blankets or other padded materials beneath it. Unroll and position the unit and locate the two inflation tubes on the back of the inflatable.
2. Place the blower in an area that is not in a direct pathway. Be sure that the blower is on a flat, dry surface.
3. Take the two inflation tubes: one of the tubes will connect to the blower, and the other tube gets tied off with the strap connected to it. Make sure that the tube that is strapped to the blower is secure.
4. **Be sure all Velcro & zippers are secured tightly. (There are six total for this unit) Three flaps are underneath the inflatable along the back. The 4th is found on the back of the inflatable about eye level. The 5th flap is located on the right side along the bottom edge, and the 6th one is found in front of the inflatable above the arch.** Plug the blower into your *dedicated 20 amp outlet*. If an extension cord is needed, you must make sure that it is industrial strength and not exceed 50 feet. Stake down the inflatable in at least two opposite corners. Cover the stakes with a suitable material to protect children while using the inflatable.
5. Locate the on/off switch on the blower and turn it on. The inflation should take approximately 3 minutes. The blower must remain on for the duration of the time that the unit is occupied.
6. Secure the net over the entrance when it is occupied.

Deflating:

1. Clean out any debris from the inside and turn off the blower.
2. Monitor inflatable as it deflates (takes about 4 minutes)
3. Attempt to roll inflatable back up. (We realize this isn't easy!)

****Cautions:**

- Keep the front of the inflatable clear and accessible at all times.
- It is recommended that 5-6 children be the maximum limit allowed in the ride at one time. The older the children, the fewer should be allowed in at once. Children should always remove shoes when entering the inflatable.
- **Adult supervision is required at all times.**
- If the inflatable is not completely dry, please do not roll it up. Inflate and let run until dry. On a sunny day, it should only take about ½ hour.
