Operating Instructions



Fog Machine

- 1. Place the remote control at a convenient spot.
- 2. To avoid the risk of electrical shock, insert the power cord into a grounded outlet only.
- 3. Fill the reservoir with recommended Fog Fluid (this may already be filled).
- 4. Close cap tightly. Push clear plastic feeder tube down through the cap (if slack).
- 5. Allow approximately 7 minutes for a warm-up time.
- 6. The machine is ready for use when the indicator light on the controller goes on.
- 7. At times, the indicator light will go off. This is normal. The machine is simply recycling. Depress the switch only when the indicator light is on.
- 8. To use timer mode, press the "Timer" button. Adjust the "Duration" knob for the length of the fog burst. Adjust the "Interval" knob for the length of time between fog bursts.
- 9. When finished, allow the fog machine to cool down before packing for transportation.

Caution:

- Ensure that there is enough fog fluid in the tank before turning the fog machine on.

 Activating the pump without fluid can cause damage to the pump and heat core.
- Vapor from this fluid may be irritating to people with allergic sensitivity. Do Not expose at close range to a known asthmatic.
- Use in a well-ventilated area.
- To avoid injury from hot steam, keep at least two feet away from the nozzle.
